Create a proposal for community action that targets the observed trend.



Receive up to \$2,000 to enable immediate action on your proposal.



Implement your change action and report how it impacts the lives of children in Elkhart County.

Application Process

Data Action Mini Grants are designed to provide access to funding with minimal barriers. These grants are a perfect tool for partners to fund a brief pilot program, community needs assessment, staff training, and/or an outreach effort, just to name a few.

A successful proposal will:

- cite data from the Child Dashboard
- have a specific action that targets a data trend
- include expected measurable outcomes
- have a start and end date for the proposed action

Who can apply for the Mini Grants?

Must be an Elkhart County organization, association, or group that serves children and/or families, and is a current or prospective collaborating partner that participates in Quarterly Child Dashboard Action Meetings.

How long does the proposal have

to be?
